DEPUTY BRAND INSPECTOR

(For future statewide vacancies including Las Vegas, Elko, Fallon and Reno)

DESCRIPTION:

Under general supervision of an assigned supervisor, Deputy Brand Inspectors inspect and identify livestock for proof of ownership, visually inspect livestock for brands, marks, tattoos, if necessary clip or shave to clearly observe markings; record identification marks, gender, and number of animals on transportation documents or other standardized forms prior to sale, or movement in or out of state. Collect appropriate fees according to established rates; submit to division office as per policies and procedures guidelines. Verify health documents when required.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:

Experience working with and/or caring for livestock in any setting; **OR** courses at the high school level and/or relevant work experience that provided the Entry Level Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

Ability to: work around and handle livestock; add, subtract, multiply, and divide accurately; read forms and documents; write clearly and complete required forms.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

A valid driver's license is required at time of appointment and as a condition of continuing employment. Incumbents are required to provide their own transportation for which mileage will be reimbursed based on the duty location.
